ESADE Excellence Honours

2019-2020 Academic Year

1. OBJECTIVE

As determined in terms and conditions of governing call for scholarships and grants of the 2019-2020 academic year, the **ESADE Excellence Honours** covers 100% of tuition fees for candidates who aim to enrol in the first year of the Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA), the Bachelor in Law (GED), the Double Degree in Business Administration and Law (GBD), the Double Degree in Law, Global Governance, Economics & Legal Order (GED&BGG) and the Bachelor in Global Governance, Economics & Legal Order (BGGELO) and who obtained a university entrance (PAU/Bachillerato or UNED Accreditation/Homologation) mark of 9.5 or higher, regardless of the specific phase.

2. APPLICABLE PROGRAMMES AND NUMBER OF GRANTS

Fundació ESADE may grant up to:

- 6 grants in the Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA)
- 1 in the Bachelor in Law (GED)
- 3 in the Double Degree in Business Administration and Law (GBD)
- 4 in the Double Degree in Law, Global Governance, Economics & Legal Order (GED&BGG)
- 2 in the Bachelor in Global Governance, Economics & Legal Order (BGGELO).

3. REQUIREMENTS AND DOCUMENTATION

To apply for the ESADE Excellence Honours:

- Candidates must be ready to enrol in the first year of any of the programmes detailed in section 2 above after having successfully presented all the required documentation and passing all the applicable tests after the minimum mark described in section 1 above has been made public.
- Have obtained a university entrance (PAU/Bachillerato or UNED Accreditation/Homologation) mark of 9.5 or higher, regardless of the specific phase.
- Submit the duly completed ESADE Excellence Honours application within the established deadline.

5. GRANT CRITERIA

Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA)

Up to 4 grants for students from the Spanish education system (PAU/Bachillerato) with a university entrance mark of 9.5 or higher, regardless of the specific phase.

Up to 2 grants for students from foreign education systems (UNED Accreditation/Homologation) with a university entrance mark of 9.5 or higher, regardless of the specific phase.

Bachelor in Law (GED)

1 grant for students from any education system (PAU/Bachillerato or UNED Accreditation/Homologation) with a university entrance mark of 9.5 or higher, regardless of the specific phase.

Double Degree in Business Administration and Law (GBD)

Up to 2 grants for students from the Spanish education system (PAU/Bachillerato) with a university entrance mark of 9.5 or higher, regardless of the specific phase.

1 grant for students from foreign education systems (UNED Accreditation/Homologation) with a university entrance mark of 9.5 or higher, regardless of the specific phase.

Double Degree in Law, Global Governance, Economics & Legal Order (GED&BGG)

Up to 2 grants for students from the Spanish education system (PAU/Bachillerato) with a university entrance mark of 9.5 or higher, regardless of the specific phase.

Up to 2 grants for students from foreign education systems (UNED Accreditation/Homologation) with a university entrance mark of 9.5 or higher, regardless of the specific phase.

Bachelor in Global Governance, Economics & Legal Order (BGGELO)

2 grants for students from any education system (PAU/Bachillerato or UNED Accreditation/Homologation) with a university entrance mark of 9.5 or higher, regardless of the specific phase.

Should any of the grants not be awarded due to the university entrance system students use, programme management may award those grants to other students who meet the requirements and access university via another system (PAU/Bachillerato or UNED Accreditation/Homologation).

6. GRANT AMOUNT

THE **ESADE Excellence Honours** covers 100% of tuition fees for the 2019-2020 academic year.

The total amount received by any ESADE student in the form of scholarships, grants and honours (excluding possible ESADE Lodging Grants and others to compensate transportation and housing expenses associated to the international exchange programme and/or SUD scholarships) may not exceed 100% of tuition fees for the academic year.

7. APPLICABLE TAX

This type of grant meets the conditions established in Article 7 in Law 35/2006, dated 28th November, on Personal Income Tax, as well as those in Article 2 in Royal Decree 439/2007, dated 30th March, approving the Regulations on Personal Income Tax, which exclude academic scholarships granted by non-profit institutions included under the special tax regime regulated by Title II in Law 49/2002, dated 23rd December.
