ESADE Innovation Honours

2019-2020 Academic Year

1. OBJECTIVE

As determined in terms and conditions of governing call for scholarships and grants of the 2019-2020 academic year, the **ESADE Innovation Honours** covers 50% of tuition fees for candidates who aim to enrol in the first year of the Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA), the Bachelor in Law (GED), the Double Degree in Business Administration and Law (GBD), the Double Degree in Law, Global Governance, Economics & Legal Order (GED+BGG) or the Bachelor in Global Governance, Economics & Legal Order (BGGELO) and who obtained a university entrance (PAU/Bachillerato or UNED Accreditation/Homologation) mark of 9.0 or higher, regardless of the specific phase, and have an entrepreneurial, innovative and global profile and are socially committed.

2. APPLICABLE PROGRAMMES

Fundació ESADE may grant up to 2 grants in each of the following programmes:

- Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA)
- Bachelor in Law (GED)
- Double Degree in Business Administration and Law (GBD)
- Double Degree in Law, Global Governance, Economics & Legal Order (GED+BGG)
- Bachelor in Global Governance, Economics & Legal Order (BGGELO)

3. REQUIREMENTS AND DOCUMENTATION

To apply for the ESADE Innovation Honours:

- Candidates must be ready to enrol in the first year of any of the programmes detailed in section 2 above after having successfully presented all the required documentation and passing all the applicable tests after the minimum mark described in section 1 above has been made public.
- Have obtained a university entrance (PAU/Bachillerato or UNED Accreditation/Homologation) mark of 9.0 or higher, regardless of the specific phase.
- Present all the documentation required in keeping with the grant criteria described in section 5 below.
- Submit the ESADE Innovation Honours application within the established deadline. Students must present all required documentation in order for their applications to be considered.
- Sit a personal interview prior to the final decision.

5. GRANT CRITERIA

Candidates will be given an overall score based on the following criteria:

Global profile:

- Number of languages the candidate speaks.
- Long-term academic experience in other countries or in Spain with a clear international component.

Innovative and entrepreneurial profile:

- A history of successfully promoting innovative organisational experiences in parallel with their academic activities.

Social commitment:

- A history of volunteering, above and beyond school-organised activities.
- A level of awareness and commitment to sustainable development and a fairer and just world as demonstrated through their extracurricular activities.

6. GRANT AMOUNT

The **ESADE Innovation Honours** covers 50% of tuition fees for the 2019-2020 academic year.

The total amount received by any ESADE student in the form of scholarships, grants and honours (excluding possible ESADE Lodging Grants and others to compensate transportation and housing expenses associated to the international exchange programme and/or SUD scholarships) may not exceed 100% of tuition fees for the academic year.

Receiving the ESADE Innovation Honours is not compatible with any other grant.

7. APPLICABLE TAX

This type of grant meets the conditions established in Article 7 in Law 35/2006, dated 28th November, on Personal Income Tax, as well as those in Article 2 in Royal Decree 439/2007, dated 30th March, approving the Regulations on Personal Income Tax, which exclude academic scholarships granted by non-profit institutions included under the special tax regime regulated by Title II in Law 49/2002, dated 23rd December.
