Her research works mainly address the analysis of corporate governance structures within business groups. Particularly, the role of interlocking directors in the agency conflict between headquarters and affiliates, and the role of women on boards of directors. She also has two other projects on ownership structures, the use of pyramids and internationalization decisions, and another ongoing project on the relationship between women on boards of directors and the risk of intellectual property litigation.
